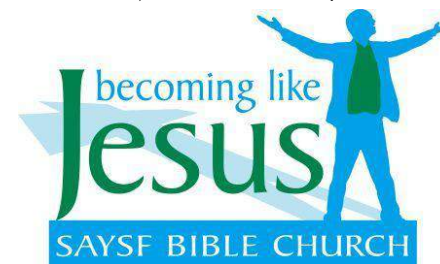
OUTBOUND YOUTH BEGINS TONIGHT 5:30 pm in the Loft of the Fellowship Center
