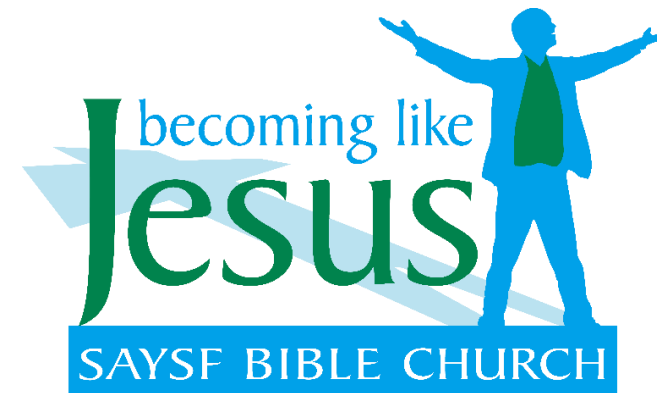

MESSAGE TO OUR GUESTS...

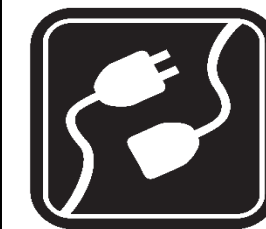

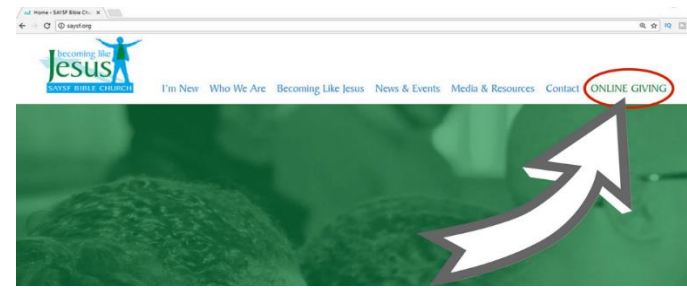

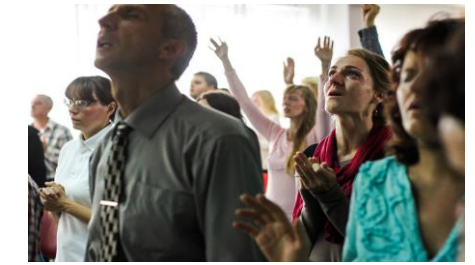
ROOTS CLASS, DECEMBER 10th

1st BIRTHDAY PARTY FOR GRACE!

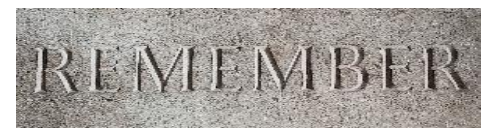
