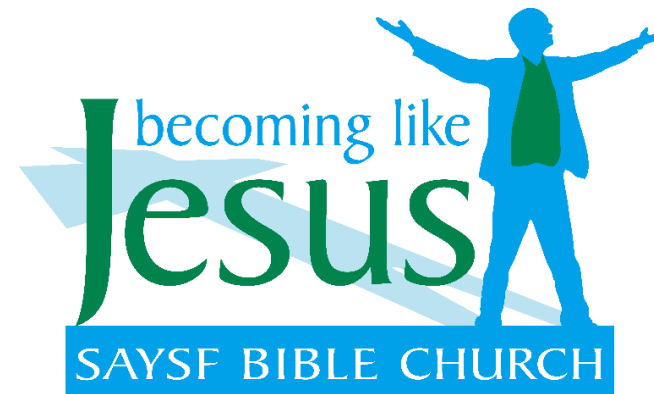

## MESSAGE TO OUR GUESTS...

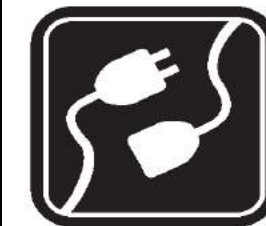
