SPECIAL CALLED BUSINESS MEETING

Next Sunday after the Worship Service

The trustees are calling a special Congregational Business Meeting for two purposes, to propose two changes to the constitution and to give a status report of the SAYSF finances.

You may find copies of the exact wording for the proposed amendments on the Welcome Table.

One proposal is to change the required number of Trustees from 7 to 3. Three Trustees is the minimum required by the state of Maryland (president, secretary, and treasurer).

This change is to preclude the dynamic of being forced to fill Trustee vacancies based on an arbitrary number of Trustees. While the minimum three required is likely insufficient to handle all the needed Trustee business, it allows the Trustees and Elders to vary the number of Trustees to allow flexibility to fill the vacancy with a willing and well-qualified person. It also would also clarify the Treasurer as a standing member of the Trustees.

The second proposal clarifies term commitments for those who fill prematurely vacant Trustee seats. It also provides means for a Trustee to extend their term by a year, vice another full 3 year term, if needed to aid term rotation schedule.
